We welcome papers on all topics, in addition to panel recommendations. We also wish to encourage proposals for a session of lightning talks consisting of five-minute research presentations on any topic.

For 5-minute lightning talks, please simply share the topic and a 2-3 sentence description. The form will also ask you to indicate your name, affiliation, and contact information, as well as any unique tech and/or accessibility requirements. Graduate students who wish to be considered for the AMS-NYSSL Student Paper Prize should check the appropriate box on the form. The submission of an abstract presupposes that the proposer agrees to present the talk should the program committee accept it.
